

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF BROWNSTOWN
PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION
NOVEMBER 1, 2012**

The regular meeting of the Charter Township of Brownstown Parks and Recreation Commission was held at the Brownstown Township Hall, 21313 Telegraph Road, on Thursday, November 1, 2012. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bryan at 7:00 p.m.

MINUTE APPROVAL: Motion of St. Louis, supported by Barbee, to approve the Parks and Recreation Commission minutes of October 4, 2012 as submitted. All voting aye.

AGENDA APPROVAL: Motion of Grady, supported by McCoy, to approve the Parks and Recreation Commission agenda of November 1, 2012 as submitted. All voting aye.

INFORMATION ITEMS:

TOWNSHIP FEEDBACK: Maxe will e-mail to members the 2013 Budget which is on the Township Board agenda for approval on Monday night.

COMMUNITY CENTER UPDATE: A repairman is coming on Monday to fix the folding partitions and also to provide an estimate for their replacement. There were enough funds approved in the 2013 DDA Budget for partition replacement but not to purchase new tables. Maxe will also be using some leftover CBDG monies to make all the Community Center interior doors and outside bathroom doors ADA accessible and to repair some concrete near the outside men's bathroom door.

PARK DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS:

TOWNSHIP CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT: The Township Campus development project is moving along. The event barn has part of the roof on and the new marquee out front of Township Hall is being worked on as well as the clock tower at King Road. The new playground site on the other side of King Road is cleared and the equipment should be moved very soon.

Maxe received another FOIA request from the mobile home park's attorney this time wanting all employee and commission members' notes on the Township Park development project.

2012 FALL PROGRAMS: Starting the second 5-week session of adult exercise classes this week. Maxe is trying to add another Zumba class for the winter session on Thursdays. The winter Newsletter is just about complete and will go to the printer this week.

OTHER BUSINESS: Maxe reported that the leasing agent for the Kroger Plaza informed him that there is a "no compete" clause with Curves so no adult classes could be held. The Patio Market owners are not interested in leasing or selling their building and he has not received a call back from the number on the Bank at Vreeland and Allen.

YOUTH BASKETBALL REGISTRATION: Basketball registration is this Monday, November 5th from 6:00 to 7:30 p.m. Maxe and Grady will take registrations at the Community Center and Wright and Barbee will be at Carlson.
