INFORMATION ITEMS:

TOWNSHIP FEEDBACK: Members discussed the Township Board's acceptance of a \$10,000 donation from Lisa Berez-Davis to place a plaque and name the plaza currently under construction west of the Community Center after her parents, Steve and Iva Berez. The plaque will be placed near the new fountain.

COMMUNITY CENTER UPDATE: Read and file, Community Center & Event Center Use Summary as of 4/29/15. Asst. Director Thomas stated that construction work is beginning again and that they are currently placing stone around the dumpster wall and fixing the concrete walkways.

PARK DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS:
