**TOWNSHIP CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT:** Work on campus project is progressing well. Concrete has been replaced around shower area, low spots in park and changing rooms, and along picnic shelter. Work continues in the fountain plaza area and on the dumpster enclosure. Concrete has been poured for flag poles and flags are up. The Splash Pad was re-coated and opened for the 2015 season on Memorial Day and will be open daily from 11 a.m. til 6 p.m. through Labor Day.

**2015 SPRING PROGRAMS:** The 2015 Spring programs are finishing up. The pre-school music programs are full. Easy Flow and Power Yoga classes are a huge success, as well as the Youth T-Ball /Softball program with 292 registrations. The Spring Rush Recreation Soccer program has 184 participants.
