ORDINANCE NO. 141-62

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 141, PART I, "INTRODUCTION", ARTICLE 1, "PURPOSE AND TITLE", SECTION 1.03, "CONFLICTING REGULATIONS", TO CREATE AN EXEMPTION FOR PUBLIC PROJECTS ON LAND OWNED BY THE TOWNSHIP

The Charter Township of Brownstown Ordains:


Section 1. Ordinance No. 141, "ZONING ORDINANCE", SECTION 1.03, is hereby amended by adding a Section (f) which shall read as follows:

"(f) Public projects on land owned by the Charter Township of Brownstown shall not be subject to the provisions of this Ordinance."


Section 2. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such article, section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Repealer. All ordinances, resolutions or orders, or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Effective Date; Publication. This Ordinance was approved and adopted by the Township Board of Brownstown Charter Township, Wayne County, Michigan, on August 3, 2015, after introduction and a first reading on July 6, 2015, and publication after first reading as required by Act 359 of the Michigan Public Acts of 1947, as amended. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon publication, in The News Herald, a newspaper having general circulation in the Township.


