ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 141-49

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 141-45, SECTION 8.02 "SCHEDULE OF USES", TO PROVIDE FOR THE ENUMERATION OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLE SALES, SERVICE & STORAGE AS A SPECIAL LAND USE IN TABLE 8.02.

The Charter Township of Brownstown ordains:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 141-45, "ZONING ORDINANCE", SECTION 8.02 "SCHEDULE OF USES" is hereby amended to read as: "14. Recreational Vehicle Sales, Service & Storage" and placed under the existing heading "Motor Vehicle Uses." The designation "SLU" shall be placed for said row 14 in the columns titled "I-1" and "I-2" only (and not the "I-RT" column). The words "Section 11.05(f)" shall be placed in the column titled "Additional Requirements" for said row 14. Thereafter, all subsequent rows will be renumbered from "15" to "57" and language of Section 8.02 shall otherwise remain unchanged.


Section 2. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such article, section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions or this Ordinance.

Section 3. Repealer. All ordinances, resolutions or orders, or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Effective Date; Publication. This Ordinance was approved and adopted by the Township Board of Brownstown Charter Township, Wayne County, Michigan, on June 7, 2010, after introduction and a first reading on May 17, 2010, and publication after first reading as required by Act 359 of the Michigan Public Acts of 1947, as amended. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon publication, in The News-Herald, a newspaper having general circulation in the Township.


