ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 141-56

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 141-45, SECTION 16.06(a) "PERMITTED SIGN REGULATIONS" BY AMENDING TABLE 12.06 (a) AND ADDING SECTION 16.06(c) (9) TO ALLOW ELECTRONIC CHANGEABLE MESSAGES.

The Charter Township of Brownstown ordains:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 141-45, "ZONING ORDINANCE", SECTION 16.06 (a) "PERMITTED SIGN REGULATION TABLE 12.06 (a)" is hereby amended to read as follows: "Ground or Monument Signs", shall reference, as an "Additional Requirement", Section 16.06 (c) (9).

Section 2. Ordinance No. 141-45, "ZONING ORDINANCE, SECTION 16.06 (c) (9) shall read:

Such signs may be allowed as all or part of a ground or monument sign provided that messages shall not scroll or blink and the message change rate shall be no less than thirty (30) seconds.

Section 3. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such article, section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions or this Ordinance.

Section 4. Repealer. All ordinances, resolutions or orders, or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Effective Date; Publication. This Ordinance was approved and adopted by the Township Board of Brownstown Charter Township, Wayne County, Michigan, on April 7, 2014, after introduction and a first reading on March 3, 2014, and publication after first reading as required by Act 359 of the Michigan Public Acts of 1947, as amended. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon publication, in The News Herald, a newspaper having general circulation in the Township.


