ORDINANCE NO. 141-60

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 141, PART V, "ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS", ARTICLE 25, "DEFINITIONS", SECTIONS 25.04 AND 25.08, "DEFINITIONS E-F AND M-N", TO INCLUDE DEFINITIONS FOR "FUNERAL HOME" AND "MORTUARY ESTABLISHMENT"

The Charter Township of Brownstown Ordains:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 141, "ZONING ORDINANCE", SECTION 25.04, "Definitions E - F", is hereby amended by adding a subsection "n" which shall read as follows:

"(n) Funeral Home. A building used for the preparation of the deceased for burial and display of the deceased and rituals connected therewith before burial or cremation. Such uses may include a limited amount of preparation of the human dead (i.e., embalming or cremation) in relation to rituals occurring on-site. A funeral home includes a funeral chapel."

Section 2. Ordinance No. 141, "ZONING ORDINANCE", SECTION 25.08, "Definitions M - N", is hereby amended by adding a subsection "h" which shall read as follows:


"(h) Mortuary Establishment. An establishment providing services such as preparing the human dead for burial and arranging and managing funerals, and may include limited caretaker facilities. This classification may include a crematorium." Thereafter, all subsequent subsections shall be lettered from "(i)" to "(o)", and the language of Section 25.08 shall otherwise remain unchanged.

Section 3. **Severability.** If any article, section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such article, section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.


Section 4. **Repealer.** All ordinances, resolutions or orders, or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed.

Section 5. **Effective Date; Publication.** This Ordinance was approved and adopted by the Township Board of Brownstown Charter Township, Wayne County, Michigan, on August 3, 2015, after introduction and a first reading on July 6, 2015, and publication after first reading as required

by Act 359 of the Michigan Public Acts of 1947, as amended. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon publication, in The News Herald, a newspaper having general circulation in the Township.


