ORDINANCE NO. 250-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDMENT TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 250, PART 25, SECTIONS 1-13 ("AMUSEMENT DEVICES; MECHANICAL") OF THE CODE OF GENERAL ORDINANCES, CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF BROWNSTOWN, TO REFLECT CHANGES IN TECHNOLOGICAL, SOCIETAL, AND CULTURAL NORMS.

The Charter Township of Brownstown ordains:

**Section 1. Purpose.**

Brownstown Ordinance No. 250, Part 25, Sections 1-13 ("Amusement Devices; Mechanical") is hereby repealed in its entirety for the reasons that it is no longer economically sustainable to enforce, and to reflect changes in technological, societal, and cultural norms.

**Section 2. Saving clause.**

A prosecution which is pending on the effective date of this Ordinance and which arose from a violation of the ordinance prior to the repeal of this Ordinance shall be tried and determined exactly as if the ordinance had not been repealed.

**Section 3. Repealer.**

To the extent that there are any conflicts between the repeal of this Ordinance and any other ordinances, parts of ordinances, resolutions or orders, such are also hereby repealed only to the extent of said conflict.

**Section 4. Effective Date; Publication.**

This Ordinance was approved and adopted by the Township Board of Brownstown Charter Township, Wayne County, Michigan, on April 2, 2018, after introduction and a first reading on March 5, 2018, and publication after first reading as required by Act 359 of the Michigan Public Acts of 1947, as amended. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon publication, in The News Herald, a newspaper having general circulation in the Township.
