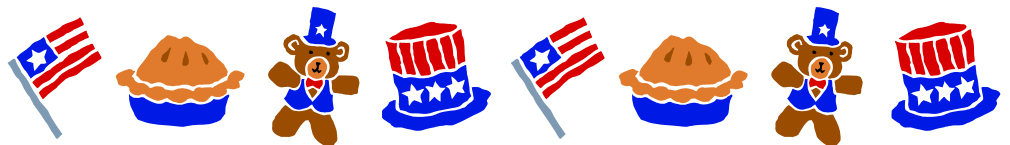

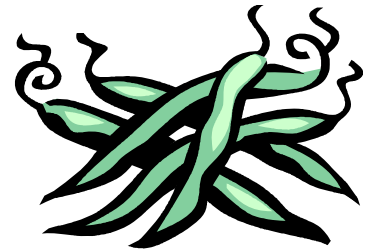
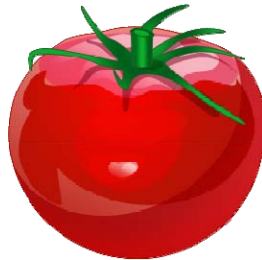

# Youth Programs

## KARATE

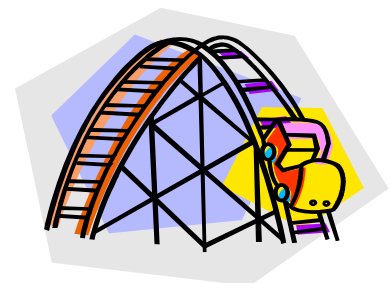

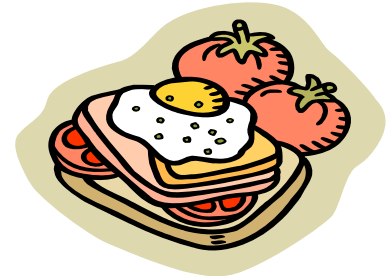
## Senior Travel Club

## HOT LUNCHES AVAILABLE

In cooperation with the Wayne County Office of Nutrition Services, Hot Lunches are available to seniors age 60 and over. Lunch is served Monday through Friday at 12:00 Noon in the Brownstown Community Center. Suggested donation is \$2.25 per meal. Reservations are due before Noon, one day in advance and can be made by calling the Recreation Department at (734) 675-0920. Monthly menus are also available for pick-up at the Recreation Offices.

Through the use of a SMART Specialized Services Grant, the Township of Brownstown is pleased to offer transportation for seniors and disabled residents.

For a \$1.00 co-pay, seniors and the disabled may ride the Senior Bus to the Community Center for scheduled activities.

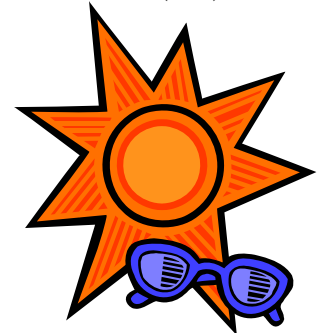
## Satisfaction Guaranteed
